Health insurance:	<p>In Italy, the National Healthcare System is provided by a public health care service (SSN). Only foreign citizens with a permit of stay may apply for the service.</p> <p>EU students are required to have the European Health Insurance Card - "TEAM / HEIC Card" (if already effective in their home country) or similar private insurance policy with international validity to benefit from a health service cover.</p> <p>Non-EU students are required to have a private health insurance policy with international validity before leaving their home country and to obtain a consular declaration of its validity for Italy (a copy certified by the Italian Consulate or Embassy), in order to get the VISA/Permit of stay.</p> <p>Be aware that it does NOT replace normal travel insurance. The insurance coverage is required for medical treatment and hospitalization.</p>											
Visa:	<p>Non EU students must apply for a study VISA prior to the arrival in Italy. A multiple entry Schengen VISA is required to visit other European countries belonging to the Schengen area.</p> <p>Application should be made at the nearest Italian Embassy/Consulate (www.esteri.it/visti/index_eng.asp)</p>											
Permit of Stay:	<p>Upon arrival in Italy, non EU students are required to apply for a Permit of Stay (permesso di soggiorno) within 8 days from their arrival, while EU students will have to register to the City Hall for a stay exceeding 90 days.</p>
