Housing:	<p>It is not easy to find suitable housing on your own while being abroad and even not after arrival in Rotterdam. The university's Housing Desk helps international students to find furnished accommodation in Rotterdam.</p> <p>Especially during the autumn term, the university receives a lot of international students and demand for housing often exceeds the number of rooms available at this Housing Desk. You are therefore strongly advised to submit an Accommodation Request Form to us (we act as the intermediary between you and the Housing Desk) as soon as possible to make a fair chance on a room that suits your preferences most.</p> <p>Be aware that the Housing Desk can only make you one offer; it will be up to you to decide whether to accept or reject this proposal.
