1. SEMINAR DESCRIPTION

PERSPECTIVE

The business environment is constantly changing. Mergers & acquisitions are one of the key drivers of these changes.

This seminar focusses on strategic thinking, context-based leadership skills and their application to mergers and acquisitions.

CONTENT

During the first part of this seminar, we will elaborate on the basic structure of an M&A deal by providing a short insight into the transaction lifecycle. Moreover, we will explore different corporate strategies behind mergers and acquisitions, discuss the challenges specific to each strategy and how they manifest during the transaction lifecycle.

The second part consists of a reflection on leadership styles in M&A situations. In particular we will reflect on leadership styles that are most suited to the different transaction strategies and stages of a transaction.

Throughout the seminar, we will use case studies based on recent transactions EY has supported.
